I have always been someone who wants to GO BIG or go home, so why not have a bigger impact in my community through a sport that has been a part of me for over 40 years. It provides players the ability to help warriors survive, women to develop relationships through sports, and develop our community into a nurturing and supportive family.

A new location at Lippold Field in association with Crystal Lake Park District

In 2017, our journey began with the standard competitive softball tournament with full support of Marengo Park District. We have since changed the location to accommodate more participants and also developed the format to encourage relationship building by selecting teams the day of the tournament. This format encourages getting to know the people normally on opposing teams and coming together for a common goal. Players are asked their positions at registration and the teams are made shortly thereafter forming very competitive teams for all. It is an amazing social, competitive, and fun day that many have reported back that "this is the best tournament I play in all year and I wouldn't miss it for anything".
